#### **Position Overview:**

## Coaching & Training:

- Lead and develop a structured training schedule for Group A and Group B, beginning in late April/early May.
- Conduct a minimum of 6 practices per week during the spring and summer months (Group A: full days, Group B: 3 weekly practices).

## • Regatta Participation:

- Take the team to at least 5 regattas, including 3 away events (e.g., Spring Dinghy/HP, Sail East, CORK) and 2 home regattas.
- Coordinate travel logistics and ensure smooth participation with the help of parent volunteers.

### • Program Development & Recruitment:

- Assist the Sailing School Head Coach in recruiting new sailors and expanding the racing program, aiming to grow the team by 50% by 2026.
- Communicate regularly with parents via WhatsApp regarding program updates and important announcements.

## • Volunteer Coordination:

 Collaborate with the parent board and volunteers for tasks such as advertising, bookkeeping, home regatta organization, coach boat maintenance, and chaperoning during travel events.
